

How to add the correct colour profile to your computer

For standard web offset ISO profiles:

- Go to www.eci.org
- Click on 'downloads' on the left hand panel
- Scroll down to 'ICC profiles from ECI'
- Download the zip/sit file called ECI_offset_2007
- Inside the downloaded folder are the relevant profiles in ICC format

For bespoke gravure profiles:

- Go to ftp.emap.com
- Username: eaproductio password: brilliant
- inside the folders 'PROFILES' are the relevant output ICC profiles

- The correct output profile for each magazine is detailed in the Bauer Advertising specifications document

To add profiles to your system:

- In Mac OS, copy profiles into the Library/ColorSync/Profiles folder
 - In Windows 2000, copy the profiles into the WINNT\system32\spool\drivers\color folder
 - In Windows XP, copy the profiles into the WINDOWS\system32\spool\drivers\color folder
 - In Windows, you can also install a profile by right-clicking it and choosing Install Profile
- How to add the correct colour profile to your computer

Applying the profile to a PDF exported from Indesign CS1:

- Go to PDF export presets and select PDF/X-1a as normal (in file/Pdf export presets)
- Select 'Advanced' in the export PDF window
- Click on 'destination profile option' and scroll down to correct profile for relevant publication
- Click on 'output intent profile' and scroll down to correct profile for relevant publication
- Export PDF as normal

Applying the profile to a PDF exported from Indesign CS2:

- Go to PDF export presets and select PDF/X-1a as normal (in file/Adobe pdf presets)
- Select 'output' in the export PDF window
- Click on 'destination' option and scroll down to correct profile for relevant publication
- The 'output intent profile name' option should display the same correct profile as above
- Export PDF as normal
