Jazz FM plays the world's greatest jazz, soul and blues from the world's greatest artists. Since its launch in 1990, Jazz FM has pioneered a new approach to broadcasting. The music output is truly unique; a colourful mixture of well-known pieces by legends including Ella Fitzgerald, Miles Davis and Nina Simone, alongside emerging artists such as Judi Jackson, Kamasi Washington and Ezra Collective.

From Monday to Friday there's the chilled relaxing sounds of Dinner Jazz, followed by a magical collection of specialist programmes to inspire and intrigue listeners. Our weekends provide landmark moments of musical discovery with some of the biggest names in jazz-music broadcasting.

Jazz FM is also at the centre of the jazz community, regularly breaking new talent through innovative initiatives such as the Jazz FM Awards, whilst also lending support to big names such as Jamie Cullum and Gregory Porter.

JAZZ FM AUDIENCE

Jazz FM's core audience is aged 35-64, 61% male and 39% female.

We attract an upscale, predominantly ABC1 audience who enjoy the quality things in life with a high disposable income. They are more likely to read The FT, The Times or The I over a traditional tabloid.

They have families, cars and like to travel but listening to Jazz FM is a constant in their lives. Our audience is passionate about music and it's the background to everything they do.

Jazz music is in the middle of a resurgence with exposure to a growing audience happening in everyday places – you'll see jazz superstars headlining mainstream big-budget entertainment TV shows such as Strictly Come Dancing and Graham Norton.

Dinner Jazz has been part of Jazz FM's output since the first day it went on air in 1990. It provides a melodic and relaxing dinner time soundtrack playing the softer end of jazz (both classic and new) six days a week. You'll hear from legends like Miles Davis, Billie Holliday and Frank Sinatra alongside the cream of today's jazz artists like Jacob Collier and Diana Krall.



WEEKENDS

Each weekend on Jazz FM is one of amazing musical discovery. Yolanda Brown brings her infectious energy to Saturday afternoons as she guides us through 4 hours of the best jazz, soul and blues. Every Sunday, Tony Minvielle presents a relaxed soulful selection of UK and West Coast jazz followed by super fresh rhythms with Robbie Vincent. From 7pm, singer and broadcaster Clare Teal celebrates the best in big band and swing before we hand over the music and microphone to our guest presenter in residence to see out the weekend.

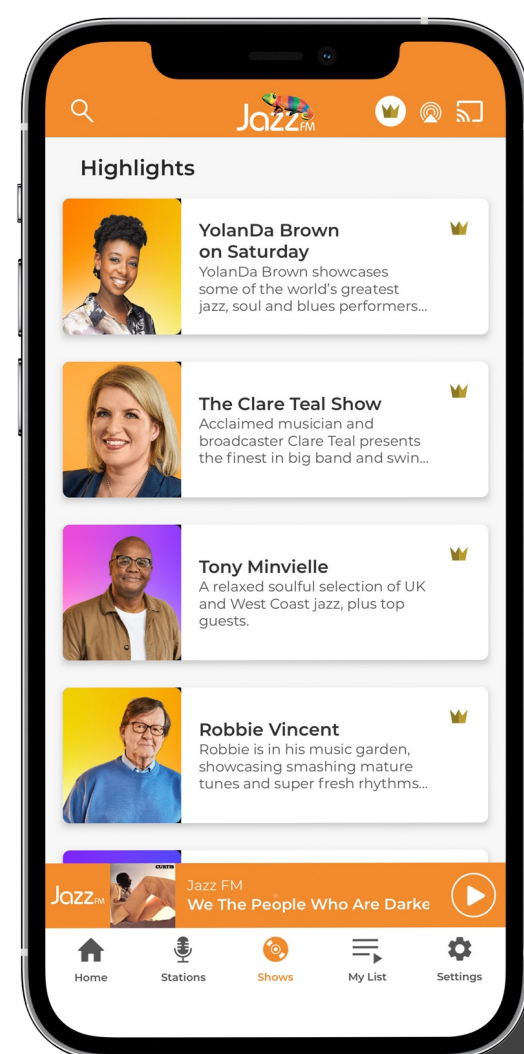
THE 9PM SLOT

LIVE EVENTS

Jazz FM co-founded the Love Supreme Jazz Festival in Sussex back in 2013, and each year we support it on-air and online with continuous live broadcasts, featuring interviews and performances from the multiple stages across the festival site. The event has grown exponentially and is now home to over 50,000 jazz, soul and funk lovers every July.

We also partner with The EFG London Jazz Festival and support small, medium and large concerts and venues right across the UK to ensure that the jazz community is always at the centre of what we do.

Our presenters have hosted programmes from the world's largest jazz festivals including those in Saint Lucia, the Netherlands (North Sea), New Orleans (Mardi Gras) and Lviv, Ukraine (Leopolis Jazz).

We frequently have artists through the doors of our studios at Jazz FM HQ for intimate and exclusive sessions, such as Jamie Cullum, Jose James, Jools Holland and even silver-screen royalty Jeff Goldblum.
